- 14 SIGNIFICANT EUCALYPTUS & BANKSIA TREES RETAINED FOR PLAY VALUE AND SHADE. SOME UNDER-PRUNING NECESSARY
- 15 MESH & STICK TUNNEL COVERED IN VINES TO ENTER ACCESSIBLE PATH AND WIDER ADVENTURE PLAY SPACE
- 16 OPEN PICNIC & ACTIVE LAWN SPACE RETAINED
